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Ice chocolate lollies

For two lollies you will need:

HEMEL HEMPSTEAD

- 1 Tablespoon of Cadbury's drinking chocolate
- 1 Tablespoon of hot water
- 1 orange
- Lolly moulds

METHOD

No-Bake Cake

You need -

- 100g margarine
- 2 rounded tablespoons golden syrup
- 200g digestive biscuits
- 50g raisins
- 2 level tablespoons cocoa powder

1. Grease a 7" round or square cake tin.
 2. In a small pan, melt the margarine and syrup. When the margarine melts, remove from the heat.
 3. Break up the digestive biscuits into fine crumbs.
 4. Put the crumbs, raisins and cocoa powder in a bowl.
 5. Stir in the melted syrup and margarine and mix well.
 6. Press the mixture in the cake tin and put into the refrigerator for a couple of hours until it is quite cool, then turn out and serve. If you want to, decorate the cake with sweets but put them on before you put the cake in the fridge.
- Enjoy your cooking!

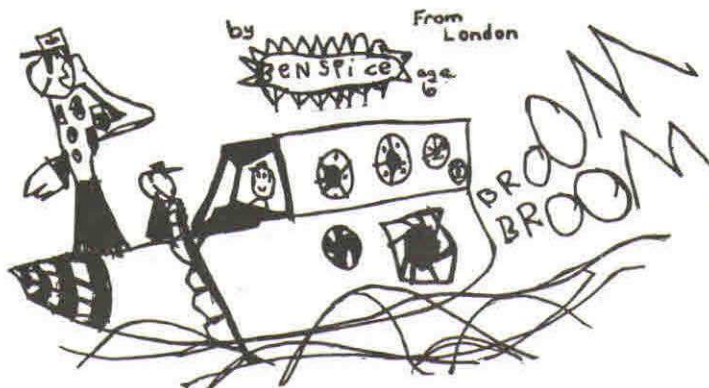
